Strategies

- Build teacher capacity in literacy across the curriculum through the Writing Task via teacher involvement in all aspects of planning, developing, marking and using data.
- Foster a whole school approach to curriculum planning and delivery through a consistent use of a planning template, that is responsive to students' social and learning needs, caters for diversity and is targeted to maximises learning growth for all students
- Drive continuous improvement in high quality learning and teaching across all key learning areas to maximise learning growth for each learner through the 4 C's: co-planning; co-teaching; co-debriefing; co-reflection.
- Build teacher capacity in the understanding and application of HYS (Data Walls, Learning Walks and Talks and Review and Response) and the effective and expected practice as per the BCE model of pedagogy to maximise learning growth for all by maximising involvement and collaboration in Twilight PD, Faculty meetings and R&R meetings.
