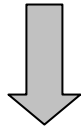

To promote and develop an authentic Catholic Community



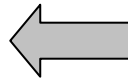
Goals for 2012

We intend to:

Continue to develop a Religious Education Curriculum that promotes knowledge, deep understanding and skills about the Catholic and broader Christian tradition

Promote professional learning for staff in religious education and theology

Develop a shared understanding of and practical responses to Catholic Social Teaching



Actions

- Sponsor teachers to gain RE accreditation via REAP and Grad Cert in RE
- Prioritise staff access to PD in RE.
- Consolidate Good Samaritan values in classes especially RE
- Review and continue to re-write some junior RE programs
- Consolidate appropriate community service program Year 10
- Encourage active student participation in local social action projects and missions e.g. Vanuatu, East Timor
- Plan for an outdoor Prayer space

We intend to:

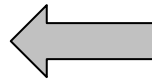
Enhance pedagogical practice that is data informed and evidence based.

Actions

- Establish a school wide pedagogical philosophy

- Professional sharing at meetings
- Have staff visit each other's classrooms
- Consistent literacy and numeracy practices across the curriculum and through extra time allocated to English and maths

Strengthen positive relationships and partnerships within and beyond the school community



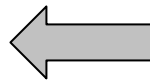
Goals for 2012

Forge productive links with professional bodies and institutions, the broader community and government agencies.



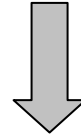
Actions

- Hold regular parent educating parent nights (PEP)
- Further development of College Website.
- Foster peer learning through concept of un-conference for staff professional development
- Consolidate partnership with NAB and SCAiP through the Student Film Festival – STUFF iT
- Continue partnership with Nambour RSL sport funding.
- Involve parents and students in staff professional develop days
- Encourage greater participation in P&F and Board
- Strengthen the partnership with SCU through Indonesian Headstart, scholarship programs and Papuan teachers

Goals for 2012

We intend to:

Allocate school resources through a strategic renewal plan informed by the principle of stewardship.

Enhance student and staff engagement with learning, teaching and school operations via a (LMS) learning management system

Use contemporary learning approaches to inform the planning design and use of facilities

Actions

- Integrate ICLTs in classrooms through software, laptop program and professional learning.
- Move to student workspaces and prepare for LMS – “Life”
- Install covered seating to MPC and provide new signage.
- Plan for continued upgrade of wireless.
- Complete Library refurbishment.
- Provide upgrade of college oval drainage.
- Plan for Year 7 arrival in building, curriculum and pastoral aspects.
- Submit “Education Brief”, develop Master Plan and possible BGA application.
- Formulate a 2013 Application for Trade Training Centre.
