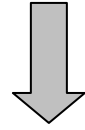

To further develop the understanding of what it means to have an authentic Catholic presence in community.

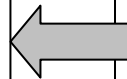
Implement the new RE guidelines to develop a Religious Education Curriculum.

Actions

- Articulate RE Vision statement for St Johns College.
- Consolidate appropriate community service opportunities.
- Encourage active student participation in local social action projects and missions eg Vanuatu, East Timor.
- Be guest and have presence to all in our "laboratory of life" as per Br Damien Price PD.

We intend to:

Develop personal pedagogical practices relating to whole school pedagogical framework- TRICE.

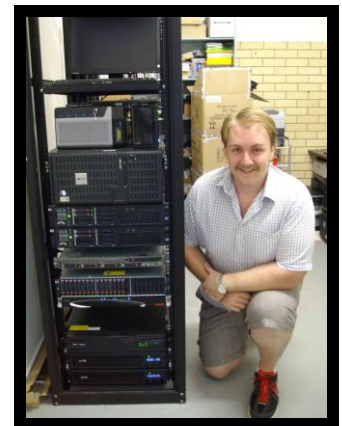
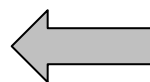
Develop and improve assessment, monitoring and reporting practices to reflect TRICE.

Finalise plans for the transition of Year 7 to secondary school.

Develop capacity to utilise information, communication and learning technologies to improve learning and teaching.

Actions

- Integrate TRICE into classroom practice
- Continue to up-skill staff in ICLT classroom practice and strategies.
- Develop teaching technologies for all subject areas- LIFE.
- Develop formative assessment and feedback practices to develop high standard outcomes for students.
- Professional sharing at meetings.
- Have staff collegially reflect on classroom practice through walk throughs, lesson videos, lesson observations.
- Target literacy and numeracy for low achievers through employment of extra specialist support teachers.
- Implement Developmental assessment procedures throughout the College.
- Support an IT Curator.
- Recognise and celebrate student achievement.
- Reflection on different needs of year 7 learners.
- Use student centred data to direct future classroom practice.

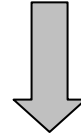

To manage resources & to effectively provide quality teaching and learning.



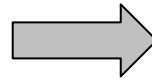
Goals for 2013

Allocate school resources through a strategic renewal plan informed by the principle of stewardship.

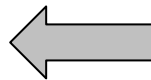
Enhance student and staff engagement with learning, teaching and school operations with the aid of the LIFE information and learning management system

Use contemporary learning approaches to inform the planning design and use of facilities for year 7 coming to secondary.



Actions

- Integrate ICLTs in classrooms through software, laptop program and professional learning
- Plan for Year 7 arrival in both building, curriculum and pastoral aspects
- Build gym to allow student access to expanded curricula
- Implement on line processes for parent teacher interviews, student educational plans, assessment checking ('Turn it in'), assessment feedback
- Build new tuckshop and demolish old tuckshop, water tower, old toilets
- Explore options for the continuation of 1-1 program in light of withdrawal of Federal funding
