General Information for Students & Parents

This is a Regional Representative Trial, not a participation event. Only players who have demonstrated the fitness and skill level to play at a representative school sport level should attend this trial. Students must register their interest with their School Sports Coordinator to receive permission forms. Students who **do not submit the required permission forms below will not be allowed to participate** in the Regional Trial and will be asked to return to their school as no supervision is provided for non-participants.

SPORT:	WATER POLO 13 – 17 Years Boys & Girls (Team for the 2018 State Championships)			
TRIAL DATE:	Wednesday 25 October 2017			
VENUE:	Nambour Aquatic Centre, Petrie Park, Nambour			
TIME:	8.45am – 2.30pm approx.			
COST:	\$20 Trial Levy which covers all trial expenses, including pool entry. Please bring exact money to trial day.			
TRIAL FORMAT:	Individual Trial: Students must register their interest through their School Sport Coordinator. Schools should ensure that only players of a suitable standard attend the regional trials. Players should be playing at a club level and preferably have some representative experience.			
AGE RESTRICTIONS:	Students must be turning 12 to 16 years of age this year . Students must be born in either 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 or 2005. They cannot turn 18 years of age in 2018.			
PERMISSION FORMS:	Students must register their interest for the trial with their School Sports Coordinator before <u>Wednesday 18 October 2017</u> . The forms listed below are to be submitted to the Regional Convenor to confirm their registration at the beginning of the Regional Trial. CATERING:	Limited canteen available. Students are encouraged to bring their own lunch and drinks.			
EQUIPMENT:	Students must bring their own togs. Water polo caps will be provided.			
SUN SAFETY	Students must supply and apply / reapply their own sunscreen at regular periods during the day. When not playing, students should be wearing their own hat and / or remain in the shade areas.			
HYDRATION:	Students must bring their own water bottle and must hydrate regularly throughout the trial.			
SHADE:	There is an undercover grandstand at the pool for spectators and students when not playing.			
REFEREES:	Participating students will be used to help referee games. Please ensure you bring a hat.			
FIRST AID:	First aid will be provided by the regional officials at the trial.			
SPECTATORS:	There is a \$2 admission fee for spectators which is payable at the gate upon entry to the pool.
