## **Conditions of Enrolment**

- It is the responsibility of students to ensure that they attend all scheduled lessons.

- Written notice must be given one week before the end of a term if lessons are not continuing.

- Lessons will only be rescheduled, at the discretion of the tutor, if sufficient prior notice (at least 48 hours), has been received by the Music Department explaining the absence. It is the students responsibility to notify the college when assessment conflicts with lesson times.
