Dear Parents and Students

On **Tuesday 16th May**, the SJC 1sts, SJC Intermediate A and SJC Junior A teams will compete in the Queensland Catholic Cup at Metropolitan Netball Courts, Wembley Park, Coorparoo, commencing at 8.30am.

This competition is usually a high-level competition and will prepare teams for finals, but also allow teams to aim for success in another competition, besides the local interschool one.

Students will travel down and back as a team on the school bus and must be at school by 5.20am (**no later**) as the bus **MUST** leave by 5.30am. We must be at the courts by 7.30am with games commencing at 8.30am. These times allow for the usual highway traffic. Games should finish by 4pm and the bus will try to get away as soon as possible after the presentations. At this stage, I don't think students will be back any earlier than 6.30pm.

Students must wear their playing uniform (including warm up shirt — 1sts and Intermediate A teams) down on the bus and be taped and ready to play on arrival. This day can be extremely hot in the sun so students must bring plenty of water, hat/visor and lots of recovery food for the day. A Round Robin is played in the morning with little breaks in between, so players are to expect a hectic schedule. We will try to find a cool place under one of the trees for extra shade where all three teams will assemble during the day. Students can also bring a chair if they want, although this is extra baggage and there is little time for its use.

Parents are also invited to attend the day, although they will have to find their own transport as the bus will be full with the players. All players **MUST** travel on the school bus with the teams. The teams will need assistance with scoring, so I would appreciate contact from any parents who may be able to attend.
