St John's College Tuition Fee Sibling Charges align with Brisbane Catholic Education set guidelines.

Second child - charged at 60% of first child tuition fee rate.

Third child - charged at 40% of first child tuition fee rate.

Fourth child - charged at 20% of first child tuition fee rate.

Additional children - No charge for tuition fees.

St John's College offers a discount off the School Tuition Fee to families who also have students enrolled at other BCE Catholic Schools on the Sunshine Coast. A 5% discount will be applied to School Tuition Fees only but not to the Student, Capital or P&F Levies.

# Fee Information

\*School fees are issued and emailed to account holders on an annual basis, usually within the first two weeks of the school year. Payment in full must be made via FACTS within 14 days of the date issued, or alternatively, a payment plan must be set up through FACTS.

\*Extracurricular Activities are Invoiced per student per Term and are added to the FACTS repayment schedule.

\*Accounts on a FACTS payment agreement will receive statements for information purpose.

## EXPLANATION OF FEES:

**Tuition Fee** Tuition Fees are used for the everyday operation of the College covering utilities, maintenance and staffing.

**Capital Levy** This is a compulsory charge per family. It is used to meet current commitments for recent building projects including the MPC refurbishment, new Hospitality and ITD buildings and the Library extension. This levy is NOT tax deductible.

**P&F Levy** This levy is charged per family and is collected on behalf of the St John's College P&F Association. It is used to fund various projects around the School, improving facilities for students.

**Student Levy** This levy covers subject costs, school camps & excursions and end of year activities for each year level. Also included are a variety of costs including the laptop program, general technology, external exam packs, on-line tutoring, student diary, ID Cards, school magazine, student welfare items, insurance, sports days, etc.

## FEE COLLECTION POLICY:

A reminder statement/notice/letter will be issued within 7 days to any family who has not entered into a payment agreement via FACTS.

If payment or a suitable response is not received within 7 days of the reminder statement, contact with the parent will be made via telephone, mail or email.

If after two weeks from this second reminder satisfactory arrangements have not been reached, the account may be sent to the college Debt Collection agency. In serious cases, where there is clear capacity to pay outstanding fees, legal options may be pursued by the college.

Legal costs and any debt collection costs or other costs incurred will be at the family's expense.

## DIFFICULTY PAYING:

It is our policy to assist families who may be experiencing any difficulties in meeting fee obligations.

Contact the College as early as possible to organise an arrangement. **All contact is strictly confidential.**

## FEE CONCESSIONS:

In cases of financial hardship an application may be made for a fee concession.

Concessions are assessed using the standard BCE Poverty line model to ensure fairness across all schools.

Concessions are valid for one year only. Consideration for a subsequent year will require a new application.
