



To develop students as independent & life-long learners




Goals for 2015

Use student centred data to direct future classroom practice.


Establish the Visible Learning group and have them implement the initiative

Host a large welcome BBQ for all of staff, parents and students.


Organise a 75th Anniversary Ball



Plan for future growth and associated educational needs.


Actions
