

Policy on Suspension from Extracurricular Events



Purpose:

To ensure that students maintain appropriate behaviour and academic standards, this policy outlines the conditions under which students will be withdrawn from participating in extracurricular events.

Scope:

This policy applies to all students participating in extracurricular events at St John's College.

Policy Statement:

Students who are suspended from school for any reason will be withdrawn from participating in all extracurricular events for the days corresponding to their suspension. Exceptional QCAA circumstances may apply.

Representing St John's is a privilege; students' behaviour and conduct in the community and the classroom is expected to align with the expectations of the College to be afforded this privilege.

Procedures:

1. Notification of Suspension:

- When a student is suspended from school, the administration will notify the student, their parents/guardians, and the appropriate key stakeholders.
- The notification will include the specific dates of the suspension.

2. Duration of Suspension:

- College staff will check if the student is enrolled in any current teams and notify the coordinator of the event that the student is unavailable on those days.

3. Reinstatement:

- After the suspension period, the student will be eligible to resume participation in extracurricular events in alignment with the school behaviour support processes.

Responsibilities:

- **College Staff:** Ensure that the policy is communicated to all students, parents/guardians, and coaches. Handle notifications.
- **Extra Curriculum Coordinator:** Enforce the suspension and support the student's reintegration into the team after the suspension period.
- **Students:** Adhere to the terms of the suspension and engage in any required meetings or conditions for reinstatement. Supporting the College during this suspension is expected.

Review and Amendments:

- This policy will be reviewed and amended as necessary to ensure its effectiveness and relevance.
